

# Pet First Aid Kit

Recommendations may vary depending on your pet and their lifestyle, or where the kit(s) are being stored (i.e. home, car, camper, etc.)

- ☐ Gloves, disposable and non-latex
- ☐ Clean cloth and/or towel
- ☐ Gauze sponges, assorted sizes in sterile and non-sterile
- ☐ Gauze roll, 2-inch wide
- ☐ Roll of elastic cling bandage, 2-inch wide
- ☐ Adhesive tape, hypoallergenic
- ☐ Small scissors
- ☐ Tweezers
- ☐ Tongue depressors
- ☐ Cotton tipped swabs
- ☐ Instant cold pack
- ☐ Grooming clippers
- ☐ Digital rectal thermometer
- ☐ Styptic powder/pencil (to stop bleeding from broken nails)
- ☐ Triple-antibiotic ointment (for use on dogs only)
- ☐ Dawn dish soap (to clean wounds)
- ☐ Hydrogen peroxide 3% (to induce vomiting)
- ☐ Syringe (children's dose size)
- ☐ Sterile eye lubricant
- ☐ Sterile petroleum jelly or water-based lubricant
- ☐ Sterile saline
- ☐ Diphenhydramine aka Benadryl (if approved by your veterinarian for allergic reactions and with no other added ingredients)
- ☐ Glucose paste or corn syrup (for low blood sugar or diabetics)
- ☐ Muzzle (injured pets can bite out of pain/fear)
- ☐ Nylon leash
- ☐ Small emergency/rescue blanket
- ☐ List of emergency phone numbers (including primary and emergency vet, and a pet poison hotline)
